



Science Syllabus for 13+ Entry

All candidates applying for entry to Year 9 are required to take a one hour science paper, which is exactly the same for scholarship and non-scholarship candidates.

The Kent College science syllabus is based on the National Curriculum for science at Key Stage 3.

Although candidates will be tested on their ability to recall factual information, some questions will be interpretative and the candidate's responses will be expected to show that she knows how to:

- a) Handle simple laboratory equipment safely.
- b) Select apparatus appropriate to an investigation.
- c) Make accurate observations and measurements.
- d) Handle data in a variety of ways including drawing diagrams and constructing tables and line graphs.
- e) Interpret data from experimental results and identify patterns in data.
