1. Society in transition in Wales and England, c. 1880-1914.

- (a) Explain why there was a demand for social reform by 1906. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the rise of the labour movement the most significant development in Wales and England between 1880-1914? [36]

2. British foreign policy, c. 1878-1914.

- (a) Explain why Britain was satisfied with the outcome of the Congress of Berlin. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the forming of ententes the main influence on British foreign policy between 1878-1914? [36]

3. Wales and England and the First World War, 1914-1918.

- (a) Explain why the First World War had an effect on the lives of women. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the contribution of the military leaders mainly responsible for Britain's victory in the First World War 1914-1918? [36]
