SECTION A

Answer one question.

1. The Conservatives in the age of Peel and Disraeli, 1834-1880

2. The development of Liberalism, 1846-1886

‘Gladstone’s outstanding achievement was to keep the Liberal Party united in the period 1866-1886.’ Discuss. [40]

SECTION B

Answer one question.

1. Social Reform c.1780-1886

‘The public health movement was the most successful of the campaigns for social reform in the period 1780-1886.’ Discuss. [40]

2. Parliamentary Reform c.1780-1886

‘Parliamentary reform always had to be forced from reluctant governments in the period 1780-1886.’ Discuss. [40]
