MIDDLE SCHOOL ASSESSMENT FRAMEWORK APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION

Introduction:

Aga Khan University Examination Board's Middle School Assessment Framework (MSAF) sets out the basic knowledge, core concepts, and general competencies necessary and appropriate for students as they progress through Grades VI-VIII.

MSAF has been specifically designed to provide students with a strong a foundation for future learning, growth and readiness at the Secondary and Higher Secondary School level.

AKU-EB's Middle School Assessment Framework is self-contained and could be adopted either independently or as a continuum to other AKU-EB qualifications at the Secondary and Higher Secondary level.

Assessment:

The Framework provides two options to assess students' progress. Schools can choose either of the two or both.

Option One: Project Portfolio

To promote interdisciplinary learning and understanding, AKU-EB has introduced general competencies that can be taught through the Schemes of Work and projects developed for the middle school years. These competencies are validated by AKU-EB through portfolio assessment. Schools opting for Project Portfolio are required to complete at least 4 projects in a class and submit and defend the assessment of their students' accomplishments in annual agreement trial meetings organized by AKU-EB.

Option Two: Progress Tests

MSAF Progress Tests measure student performance in English, Mathematics and General Science. Progress test results are one of the factors (but not the only factor) helpful for teachers and parents in evaluating students' preparedness for success in Secondary School and beyond.

Support to Schools:

To support schools in implementing the Middle School Assessment Framework, AKU-EB provides subject specific Schemes of Work in English, Urdu, Mathematics, Social Studies and General Science at each grade level. Teachers from the schools registering for Project Portfolio also receive training in an orientation workshop on Project-Based Learning. They further have the opportunity for professional development in annual Agreement Trial Meetings (ATM) held to validate schools' assessment of their students' portfolios.
