Des caméras pour protéger ou surveiller ?

Les premières caméras de surveillance ont été installées pour aider la police à régler la circulation. Progressivement, ce système s'est étendu aux transports en commun, magasins, lieux de travail et de loisirs, rues, parcs, écoles... Le but de toutes ces caméras ? Lutter contre l'insécurité et la délinquance, faire de la prévention, maintenir l'ordre...

Si cette multiplication de caméras apporte un sentiment de sécurité, elle soulève quelques problèmes. Premièrement, la vidéosurveillance ne fait que déplacer la délinquance. Autrement dit, les voleurs et autres petits voyous vont dans les endroits non surveillés, ce qui pousse à installer encore plus de caméras. Deuxièmement, dans un magasin, la caméra destinée à surveiller les éventuels voleurs peut être utilisée pour espionner les employés... Troisième problème : le respect de la liberté. En effet, dans un pays démocratique, chacun a le droit de circuler librement sans être observé. Or, avec la vidéosurveillance, le risque d'être observé sans cesse est grand – à Londres, par exemple, chaque habitant peut être filmé jusqu'à 300 fois par jour ! – ce qui veut dire que la vie privée n'est nullement respectée.

Pas surprenant que certains réclament une « loi caméra » qui préciserait, entre autres, les conditions dans lesquelles une caméra serait autorisée et l'utilisation qui pourrait être faite des images enregistrées.
