You read this recipe.

Ginger Sponge



You need:

- 100g flour
- 100g sugar
- 100g butter
- 3 eggs
- 2 large spoonfuls of syrup
- 1 large spoonful of treacle
- 1 small spoonful of ginger

1. Put the oven on at 190°C or Gas mark 5.
2. Mix together the butter and sugar.
3. Add the treacle, syrup and eggs and mix well.
4. Add the flour and ginger and beat well.
5. Put the mixture into an 18cm tin.
6. Bake in the oven for 25 minutes.
7. Turn out onto a cooling rack and leave for 15 minutes before eating.
