how much you usually spend when you go to the shops.

3. Choose one question - (a) or (b).

- (a) You want to spend your holidays on a campsite in France with your family. Write a letter to the owner using full sentences. Write about 90 – 100 words. [20]

Start and end the letter in the appropriate manner.

Say:

- when you will arrive
- when you will leave
- how many will be staying
- what sort of facilities you require (give 2 details)
- why you have chosen this campsite
- how many times you have been to France before.

Ask: for directions to the campsite from the bus station.

- (b) While you were in France with your family you had an accident and had to go to hospital. Write a letter to your penfriend about it using full sentences. Write about 90 – 100 words. [20]

Start and end the letter in the appropriate manner.

Say:

- when the accident happened
- what you were doing at the time
- how badly you were hurt (give 2 details)
- how long you spent in hospital
- what you did to pass the time in hospital
- when you hope to go on your next holiday.

Ask: if your penfriend has ever been in hospital.
