Young broadcasters from various schools across the country gathered together in May when the awards for the Radio Competition for Young People were presented.

This competition, which is always in great demand is organised by Gael Linn, an Irish language organisation based in Dublin.

The competition is aimed at transition year students primarily as they can use the programme as part of the transition year projects which at the same time improves their communication and spoken Irish skills.

That said, any student attending second level education may participate in the competition. It is an excellent opportunity for those who are interested in a career in the media be it as a producer, reporter or presenter.

The applicants create a radio programme of between fifteen and twenty minutes in length on a topic of their own choice.

The adjudicator, Brídóg Ní Bhuachalla greatly praised the standard of entries. She said she was delighted that there was a remarkable increase in the number of entries this year.

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
