Subject: GCSE Gujarati entries

GCSE GUJARATI ENTRIES

We would like to clarify entry code requirements for GCSE Gujarati and thus avoid the confusion that is sometimes experienced by some centres. The aim is to reduce the amount of incomplete entry information received and last minute changes of units.

- To claim a qualification, a certification entry must be made, e.g. 1927 GCSE Gujarati.
- The qualification code alone will not trigger the despatch of examination materials. There must be an entry for each skill at either Foundation or Higher Tier and an appropriate unit code.
- Candidates must take a valid combination of units. Please note that units 2375 and 2376 are both internally assessed and may not be taken together.

We include a table from the OCR Administration Guide and Entry Procedures Manual which clearly shows the relationships between entry codes and lays out the rules of combination.

We hope that this information is helpful.
