Topic 1: Arabia on the eve of the emergence of Islam

- 1. "It was Mecca's economic and religious role that contributed to the emergence of Islam."

- **2.** Evaluate the key features of the society into which the Prophet Muhammad was born.

Topic 2: The life of the Prophet Muhammad

- **3.** What were the major challenges that the Prophet Muhammad faced in the establishment of his authority in Medina? How did he overcome these challenges?
- **4.** What were the main characteristics of the new community (umma) established by the Prophet Muhammad in Medina?

Topic 3: The expansion of the Islamic community

- 5. "It was the statesman Umar b. al-Khattab who consolidated the Islamic state founded by the Prophet Muhammad." Discuss this statement.
- **6.** "The Arab Muslim conquests were an inevitable outcome of the policy of expansion introduced by the Prophet Muhammad." Assess the validity of this statement.

- 7. Examine the importance of the battle of Siffin.
- **8.** What solutions to the problem of rightful succession to the Prophet Muhammad emerged in the early Islamic period (up to 750 AD / 132 AH)?

- **9.** "Only Umar II is worthy of the title 'the Rightly Guided caliph' among the Umayyads." Discuss this statement.
- **10.** Assess the achievements of the Umayyad caliph Abd al-Malik b. Marwan.

Topic 6: The Abbasid dynasty 750–861 AD / 132–247 AH

- 11. How Islamic was the early Abbasid state?
- **12.** Discuss the achievements of the Abbasid caliph Harun al-Rashid.

Topic 7: The Crusades; the threat from the West 1096–1291 AD / 489–690 AH

- 13. "The Crusades were a series of campaigns in which European forces attacked Muslim-controlled Palestine in an attempt to bring the Holy Places under Christian protection." How does the Muslim perspective of the Crusades differ from this Eurocentric view?
- **14.** What factors contributed to the success of the First Crusade?

- **15.** "The effect of Genghis Khan's conquests were undeniably catastrophic." Discuss this statement.
