- **2 for accomplishment**: getting the message across sufficiently well to be understood by a sympathetic native speaker. This does not imply accuracy, so full marks can be obtained with errors of spelling and syntax which do not obstruct comprehension. Where the candidate uses incorrect verb forms, such as the continuous present in a language that does not have one, this is deemed to impede communication.
- 1 for partial accomplishment: with doubts remaining as to whether the message gets through.

1 marks	Substantially inaccurate, with only isolated examples of accurate usage.
