Question A6.

Secure Socket Layer (SSL) in an Internet communication protocol. What is its function and why is it important when using a website? (5 marks)

Question A7.

There are various types of user documentation that are produced for the users of a website.

Describe **TWO** types of User Documentation you would like to receive when a website goes live. (5 marks)

Question A8.

Cascading Style Sheets (CSS) version1 was released in 1996. CSS version 2 was released in 1998. CSS version 3 was released in 2010. Give and describe TWO

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additional features which were made available with the release of either CSS v2 v3.
