Περσεὺς υἱὸς ἦν Διὸς καὶ Δανάης. μετὰ δὲ ἄλλους πόνους πορευόμενος πρὸς Αἰθιοπίαν, ἥς ἐβασίλευσε Κηφεύς, ηὗρε τὴν τούτου θυγατέρα, Ἀνδρομέδαν, δοθεῖσαν βορὰν θαλασσίων κήτει. Κασσιόπεια γάρ, ἡ Κηφέως γυνή, Νήρησιν ἦρισε περὶ κάλλους, καὶ πασῶν εἶναι κρείσων ηὐχησεν· αἱ δὲ οὖν Νήρηδες βαρέως ἔφερον, καὶ Ποσειδῶν συνοργισθεὶς κῆτος ἔπεμψεν ἐπὶ τὴν Αἰθιοπίαν· ἀναγκασθεὶς δὲ ὑπὸ τῶν πολιτῶν Κηφεὺς προύθηκεν Ἀνδρομέδαν τῷ κήτος. ταύτην θεασάμενος ὁ Περσεύς, καὶ ἐρασθείς, διέφθειρε τὸ κῆτος, καὶ ἔλαβεν Ἀνδρομέδαν γυναῖκα.

A. Translate into English: (40)

Τῷ δὲ Κροίσῳ ἐπέστη ὄνειρον, σημαῖνον ὅτι ὁ παῖς ἀπολεῖται, αἰχμῇ σιδηρῷ βληθείς. διὰ τοῦτο οὐκ ἤθελε τὸν υἱόν, "Ἄτυν ὄνομαζόμενον, ἐκπέμπειν. ἀλλ' ἵκετεύοντος" Ατυος ἐνέδωκε, καὶ φύλακα τοῦ παιδὸς τὸν Ἀδραστον ἐπιστήσας ἔξεπεμψεν.

'Αφικόμενοι οὖν εἰς τὸν "Ολυμπὸν τὸν κάπρον ἐζήτουν καὶ εύρόντες περιεστησαν κύκλῳ, καὶ ἐστηκόντιζον. ἐνθα δὴ ὁ Ἀδραστος ἀκοντίζων τοῦ μὲν κάπρου ἥμαρτε, τυγχάνει δὲ τοῦ Κροίσου παιδός. οὔτως ἔξεπλησε τὸ ὄνειρον. ὁ δὲ Κροίσος, Οὐ σὺ τοῦδε τοῦ κακοῦ αἴτιος, ἔφη, ἀλλὰ θεός τις ὃς μοι προύσήμαινε τὰ μέλλοντ' ἔσεσθαι.

(*Polynices leads an army to Thebes to reclaim the throne from his brother Eteocles.*)

ἀδελφοὶ ἦσαν Πολυνείκης καὶ Ἐτεοκλῆς, ἀμφότεροι βασιλεύοντες ἐν ταῖς Θήβαις. ἀλλ’ ὁ Ἐτεοκλῆς, τὸν ἀδελφὸν ἐλαύνων ἐκ τῆς πόλεως, βασιλεὺς ἐγένετο μόνος. ὁ οὖν Πολυνείκης, φυγὼν εἰς ἄλλην πόλιν καὶ παρασκευάσας μεγάλην στρατιάν, ἐπανῆλθε πρὸς τὰς Θήβας, ἐθέλων ἢ νικᾶν ἢ ἀποθανεῖν. πολὺν δὲ χρόνον αἱ στρατιαὶ ἐμάχοντο, ἀλλ’ οὐδεὶς ἐνίκησε. τέλος δ’ οἱ δύο ἀδελφοὶ ἐμαχέσαντο ἐπ’ ἄλληλους καὶ ἀμφότεροι ἐν τῇ μάχῃ ἐπεσον. καὶ τὸν μὲν Ἐτεοκλέα οἱ πολῖται ἔθαψαν μεγίστη τίμη, τὸν δὲ Πολυνείκη ἐλιπον ἐπὶ τῆς γῆς. ἡ δ’ Ἀντιγόνη, ἡ τῶν νεανιῶν ἀδελφή, ἐζήτησε τὸ τοῦ Πολυνείκους σῶμα καὶ ἔθαψεν αὐτόν.

ἀμφότερος: both. παρασκευάζω: I prepare. στρατιά: army.
 ἢ ... ἢ ...: either ... or ... θάπτω: I bury. τίμη: honour. σῶμα: body.

4. Read the following passage and then answer *any six* of the questions which follow:

(*The Giants threaten the Gods on Mount Olympus.*)

ὁ δὲ Ζεύς, νικήσας τοὺς Τιτᾶνας καὶ εἰς Τάρταρον πέμψας, ἐν τῷ Ὁλύμπῳ ἐβασίλευε σὺν τοῖς ἄλλοις θεοῖς. τοῖς δὲ γίγασι, τοῖς τῆς Γῆς παισί, σώματα μεγάλα καὶ δεινὰ ἦν· σύμμαχοι δὲ τοῖς θεοῖς οὐκ ἥθελον εἶναι. οἱ οὖν γίγαντες μάχην παρεσκεύαζον, ἐν νῷ ἔχοντες τοὺς θεοὺς ἐκ τοῦ Ὁλύμπου ἐλαύνειν.

τέλος δ’ οἱ γίγαντες τοῖς θεοῖς εἶπον τάδε· “εὐθὺς δεῖ ὑμᾶς ἐκ τοῦ Ὁλύμπου φεύγειν· ῥᾳδίως γὰρ δυνάμεθα ὑμᾶς διαφθείρειν.” πάντες δ’ οἱ θεοὶ ἐφοβοῦντο· ὁ δὲ Ζεὺς ἔφη, “ὦ Ἡρακλῆς μόνος ἡμᾶς σώσει.” ἄγγελον δ’ ἐπεμψε πρὸς τὸν Ἡρακλέα καὶ ἐκέλευσεν αὐτὸν παρεῖναι. ἐπειτα δ’ ὁ Ἡρακλῆς, ἀνδρείως μαχόμενος, τοὺς γίγαντας ἀπέκτεινε καὶ τοὺς θεοὺς ἔσωσε.

Τάρταρος: Tartarus (the underworld). σῶμα: body. σύμμαχος: ally.
 παρασκευάζω: I prepare. σώσει: “will save”. σώζω: I save.

- (c) What did the Giants have in mind to do?
- (d) What did the Giants say to the Gods?
- (e) What did Heracles do?
- (f) Give the First Person, Singular Number, Present Tense of *two* of the following verbs:
ἥθελον, ἐκέλευσεν, μαχόμενος.
- (g) Give the Genitive Case, Singular Number of *two* of the following nouns:
μάχη, θεός, παῖς.
- (h) The word *chronology* is derived from two Greek words. What are they, and what does each Greek word mean?
