A. Translate into English: (40)

Ἡ Ἀφροδίτη, Διὸς καὶ Διώνης θυγάτηρ, θεὸς ἦν τοῦ ἔρωτος. Ἡσίοδος δὲ ὁ ποιητὴς λέγει ὅτι ἀπ' ἀφροῦ τῆς θαλάττης ἐγένετο, καὶ ἐπὶ τὴν Κύπρον — φιλτάτη δὲ ἡ νῆσος τῇ θεῷ — ὑπὸ τῶν κυμάτων ἡνέχθη. ἔρωσα δὲ καλοῦ νεανίου, τοῦ Ἀδωνιδος, ἀποθανόντος ὑπὸ κάπρου ἐκείνου, βαρέως ἔφερεν. καὶ μὴν πρὸς Ἡραν καὶ Ἀθηνᾶν ἥρισεν ἡ Ἀφροδίτη περὶ τοῦ κάλλους· ἐκρινε δὲ Πάρις, Πριάμου υἱός, ὃς τὸ μῆλον Ἀφροδίτη ἔνειμεν.

Δεύτερος — ως ἔπος εἰπεῖν — Ἡρακλῆς ἦν ὁ Θησεύς· καὶ γὰρ οὗτος γίγαντας καὶ ὄλλα θηρία διέφθειρε, σφόδρα ἵσχυρὸς ὡν. πατὴρ δὲ Θησέως Αἴγευς, τῶν Ἀθηναίων βασιλεύς. ὄθλους δ' ὑπέμεινεν ἔξ ὁ Θησεύς, ἀκίνδυνον ποιῶν τὴν ἀπ' Ἰσθμοῦ πρὸς Ἀθήνας ὁδόν. πρὸς δὲ τὰς Ἀμαζόνας πολεμῶν, Ἰππολύτην τὴν Ἀμαζόνων βασίλισσαν ἔγημε. καὶ μὴν μετὰ τοῦ φίλου Περιθόου εἰς Αἴδου κατῆλθεν, ως Περσεφόνην ἀρπάσων.

(Socrates and Alcibiades meet some sailors who are on their way to the Piraeus, the harbour of Athens.)

ό οὖν Σωκράτης καὶ ὁ Ἀλκιβιάδης τῇ ἀγορᾷ προσχωροῦσιν. οἱ δὲ ἡδέως καὶ βραδέως βαίνουσιν. ὁ γὰρ Σωκράτης ἐστι διδάσκαλος καὶ φιλεῖ βαίνειν τε καὶ λέγειν. ὁ δὲ Ἀλκιβιάδης ἀκούειν τοῦ Σωκράτους φιλεῖ· οἱ δὲ λέγουσι περὶ τῆς πόλεως καὶ περὶ τοῦ πολέμου.

ἐνταῦθα δὴ τοὺς ναύτας βλέπουσιν. ὁ δὲ Ἀλκιβιάδης καὶ ὁ Σωκράτης, “χαίρετε, ω̄ ἀνδρεῖοι ναῦται,” φασὶ καὶ ἔρωτῶσι, “ποῖ βαδίζετε;” οἱ δὲ ναῦται λέγουσι, “τῷ Πειραιεῖ προσχωροῦμεν· νῦν γὰρ πόλεμός ἐστι, καὶ οἱ Λακεδαιμόνιοι Ἀθήναζε προσχωροῦσιν.”

ἡδέως: happily. διδάσκαλος: teacher. περὶ (+ Genitive Case): about, concerning.
ἔρωτάω: I ask. ποῖ: to where. πόλεμος: war. Λακεδαιμόνιος: Spartan.

4. Read the following passage and then answer *any six* of the questions which follow:

(It's story time. Philip and Melissa argue about the theme.)

ό μὲν οὖν Φίλιππος καὶ ἡ Μέλιττα μῦθον ἀπὸ τῆς Μυρρίνης ἀκούειν ἔθελουσιν. ἡ δὲ μήτηρ λέγει· “τί δέ; ποῖον μῦθον ἔθελετε ἀκούειν;” ὁ δὲ Φίλιππος· “ἔγὼ μὲν μῦθον περὶ δεινοῦ καὶ μεγάλου θηρίου ἀκούειν ἔθελω.” ἡ δὲ Μέλιττα· “ἔγὼ δὲ μῦθον περὶ καλῆς κόρης ἀκούειν ἔθελω.”

ἡ δὲ μήτηρ λέγει· “μὴ βοᾶτε, ω̄ παῖδες· ὁ γὰρ πατὴρ καθεύδει. δεῦρο δὲ ἔλθετε καὶ καθίζετε· ἔγὼ μὲν γὰρ ύμιν καλὸν μῦθον λέγειν μέλλω. ἐν δὲ τῷ μύθῳ καλὴ γυνὴ ἔνεστι, καὶ ἀνδρεῖος ἀνήρ καὶ θηρίου μέγα καὶ δεινόν. μὴ οὖν θορυβεῖτε ἀλλὰ ἀκούετε.”

ποῖος: what kind of? περὶ (+ Genitive Case): about, concerning. θηρίον: a beast.
μέλλω: I am about to. θορυβέω: I make noise.

- (a) What do Philip and Melissa want to hear?
- (b) What kind of story does Philip want to hear?
- (c) What kind of story does Melissa want to hear?
- (d) Why does the mother tell the children not to shout?
- (e) What does she tell them to do then?
- (f) Name *two* things that Myrrhine says will be in the story.
- (g) Give the Genitive Case, Singular Number, of *two* of the following nouns:
Φίλιππος, μήτηρ, κόρη, θηρίον.
- (h) The word *acoustics* comes from a Greek word. What is it, and what does the Greek word mean?

- (a) The good slave walks quickly to the beautiful house. (16)
- (b) "Come here, slave, and carry the plough to the field!" (16)
- (c) The mother leads her children home from the spring. (16)

 - (i) He was father of the gods and carried a thunderbolt.
 - (ii) He was the god of the sea.
 - (iii) She taught humans how to cultivate corn.
 - (iv) She was the goddess of archery.

Write a short paragraph about *any one* of the gods or goddesses you have named.
