There will be an interval of 30 minutes duration between the end of the first part of the examination and the commencement of the second part of the examination.

The time allowed for the drawing of human forms is one and a half hours, which includes all rest periods for the model.

During the examination the Superintendent will return the envelope containing your 2D project work to you. When the examination is completed, place your drawings in the Department of Education and Science envelope which already contains your project work, then seal the envelope.

You are required to make a study from either category **A** Natural Forms **OR** category **B** Man-Made Forms **AND** one study from category **C** Human Forms.

Choose one only from the following categories A or B.

A. NATURAL FORMS. *Time allowed* 9.30 - 10.30

From any of the following or similar forms, make a drawing of the complete form **OR** of a part of the form which is of particular interest to you.

Fruit, Berries, Vegetables.

Flowers, Plants, Vegetation, Twig/Branch, Roots.

Shells, Bones, Feathers.

Driftwood, Seaweed, Fossils, Bog oak.

B. MAN MADE FORMS. Time allowed 9.30 - 10.30

From any of the following or similar forms, make a drawing of the complete form **OR** of a part of the form which is of particular interest to you.

Goggles, Helmet, Scarf, Footwear.

Drawing, Painting or Photographic equipment.

Small handtools, Machine parts.

Musical instruments, Headphones, Microphone.

Interval from 10.30 - 11.00. Re-commencement of examination at 11.00.

C. HUMAN FORMS. Time allowed 11.00 - 12.30.

Make a drawing of the complete figure **OR** make a drawing of the head and shoulders.

Model is seated with one foot on the ground and the other on a low box or thick book, arms folded. Model is looking straight ahead.

Detailed drawing of features, such as face and hands, is not required.
