- (a) Help their allies; wealth of Egesta; restrict power of Syracuse .
- (b) Arrest & defection of Alkibiades; death of Lamakhos; indecision of Nikias; arrival of Gylippos; failure to complete walls; eclipse of moon.
- (c) Strongly favoured it; energetic general; defected & advised Spartans to aid Syracuse.
- (d) Eleusinian Mysteries: Rites of Demeter, held in Eleusis for initiates only; Alkibiades accused of profane performances in private houses.

Hermokrates: Wanted Syracusans to attack defeated Athenians immediately; then sent message to Nikias not to retreat till next day.

Demosthenes: Established general; brought reinforcements; foiled by Nikias' tardiness; executed.

ἐξελάσειαν : Optative in Conditional sentence in Indirect Speech .

- (a) Teiresias. Oedipus has accused him of plot with Kreon because he will not answer questions,
- (b) Concerned ruler; determined detective; short fuse; religious; unseeing victim of fate.
- (c) Calms Oedipus; mocks oracles; sends for witness; first to realise incest; commits suicide.
- (d) Laios: Former king; father of Oedipus; unsolved murder pollutes Thebes; aggressive to passer-by.

Kithairon: Mountain range near Thebes where baby Oedipus was handed over.

Sphinx: Winged lion/dog/woman; plague at Thebes; question and answer.

- (i) Euripides (480 – 406 BC): Not politically active; left Athens for Macedonia (408 BC) where he died..
Plays have ordinary characters, driven by passion, prologues. deus ex machina.

 - (ii) Plato (427 –348 BC): Pupil of Socrates; travelled widely, incl Syracuse; founded Academy; shunned current Athenian politics.
Contribution: Record of Socrates; dialectic method; theory of Ideas; huge influence on later philosophers.
