 - good sense of register.

- (d) Include "Irlande" accept "Ireland"/ "Éire".

Top of Page/Closing Formula.

1 mistake - ignore.

2 mistakes - deduct 1 mark.

3 mistakes - deduct 2 marks.

More than 3 mistakes - award 0.

Treat one or more incorrect accents in closing formula as one mistake.

N.B.

If candidate has general layout of Top of Page correct,

despite numerous mistakes - award ONE mark.
