- (c) Write a short essay outlining the traditions and values to be handed on to children within the Jewish family. Support your answer with reference to the Bible and Mishnah. (50)

- (a) Situate the passage above within its wider historical and political context. (25)
- (b) Parse and translate the following three words: (25)
- (c) Write a short essay outlining the conflict between the personal/family life of David and his role as king. Support your answer with historical and biblical references. (50)

- (a) To what extent does the passage above sum up the role and mission of Jeremiah? (25)
- (b) Suggest a suitable title in Hebrew for the passage above. (25)
- (c) Write a short essay outlining the attitude of any **one** prophet towards the official cult and worship in Ancient Israel. Support your answer with historical and biblical references. (50)

- (a) In which way does the philosophy contained in the passage above summarise the entire message of the Book of Ecclesiastes? (25)
- (b) Suggest a suitable title in Hebrew for the passage above. (25)
- (c) Write a short essay outlining how the biblical ideas of Wisdom are continued and developed in the Mishnah. Support your answer with reference to the Bible and Mishnah. (50)
