

Ezulwini Lodges

'Ezulwini' beteken 'Paradys' in Zoeloe. Dit is 'n plek waar Afrika ongerek bly en waar die sikkels van die lewe voortgaan net soos aan die begin van alle tye.

Die Ezulwini Lodges is in die Balule-gedeelte van die wêreldberoemde Nasionale Krugerwildtuin geleë. Albei is in wonderlike afgesonderde plekke; een op die oewer van die magtige Olifantsrivier en die ander op 'n koppie wat oor die Bosveld uitkyk.

Akkommodasie bestaan uit grasdak-chalets met twee enkelbeddens, en-suite fasilitate, elektrisiteit, insekbestaande skerms, oorhoofse waaiers, mini-kroë en tee en koffie. Skotteltelevisie en telefoon- en faksfasilitate is ook beskikbaar en die water is drinkbaar.

By Ezulwini word vriendelikheid en informaliteit beklemtoon. U persoonlike wildbewaarder sal sy kennis van die bos en diere gedurende wildbesigtigingstoere op 'n oop safarivoertuig met u deel. Hierdie besigtigingstoere vind vroeg soggens en laatmiddag plaas. In die laatmiddag sal hy u voorstel aan die wêreld van allerlei nagdiere en sodra die son agter die Drakensberg verdwyn, sal hy stop vir skemerkelkies onder die sterrehemel.

Saans, wanneer u in die boma om die kampvuur sit en die uitmuntende Afrika-disse geniet, is dit nie onmoontlik om die gebrul van 'n leeu, gevvolg deur 'n koor van hiënas en jakkalse in die agtergrond te hoor nie. Een van die mees spannende staptogte is sekerlik deur gebiede waar leeus voorkom. Hier bestaan die ekosisteem uit plantegroei soos grasvelde en doringbosse. Gaste sal hier ook nader aan die natuur se kleiner diertjies, voëls en ander boomsoorte kan kom.

Terug by die kamp, lok die koel water van die swembad voordat u u gereed maak om in 'n sjarmante en tipiese Afrika-chalet te gaan slaap.

Ezulwini Lodges

In the Zulu language, 'Ezulwini' means 'Paradise'. In this place, Africa has remained unspoiled and the cycles of life continue as they had since time began.

The Ezulwini Lodges are situated in the Balule section of the famous Kruger National Park. Both are in gloriously secluded locations, one against the banks of the mighty Olifants River and the other on a hillside overlooking the Bushveld.

Accommodation is in thatched chalets with twin beds, en-suite bathroom and electricity, insect-proof screens, overhead fans, mini-bars and a tea/coffee tray. Satellite TV and telephone/fax are available - and you can drink the water.

At Ezulwini the emphasis is on friendliness and informality. Your personal game ranger shares his experiences of the bush and the animals during game drives in an open safari vehicle, usually in the early morning or late afternoon. At dusk he'll invite guests into the world of the nocturnal creatures, stopping for sundowners as the sun sinks behind the Drakensberg Mountains.

In the evening, while sitting around the campfire in the boma, enjoying superb meals cooked the African way, guests may hear the lions roar while the hyenas and jackals join in the chorus. One of the most thrilling walks is through lion country, an ecosystem where the vegetation is typically composed of long grass and thorn bushes. Here one walks among the birds and the trees, where guests get closer than they could ever imagine to nature's smaller creatures.

Back at camp, the swimming pool invites you to cool down before retiring to your charming African chalet.

Come to Ezulwini – the paradise – and leave with an experience of Africa that you'll remember forever.

Le Saint Geran, Mauritius, Hotel van die Jaar 2002

Le Saint Geran, die luukse vlagskip van Sun Internasional in Mauritius, is deur lesers van die Brits gebaseerde tydskrif, **Tatler** gekies as "Hotel van die Jaar".

Victoria Mather, reisredakteur van die **Tatler**, wat verantwoordelik was vir die **2002 Tatler se Gids van die Wêreld se 101 Hotelle**, het glo gesê dat goeie diens en nogmaals goeie diens hierdie hotel die hotel van die jaar gemaak het. Daar is selfs 'n man in 'n wit kortbroek wat die gaste se sonbrille op die strand skoonmaak!

Hierdie vyfster-hotel is alles waarvan 'n mens slegs kan droom. Le Satin Geran is geleë tussen 5000 palmbome op 'n 60-akker skiereiland en bevat 'n asemrowende mooi privaatstrand van ongeveer 2 km lank, en het 'n lagune aan die een kant en die Indiese Oseaan aan die ander. Die hotel is 'n lid van die 'Leading Hotels of the World'-organisasie en is bekend vir sy veilige ligging, asook vir uitstekende diens, informele atmosfeer en die aandag wat aan elke klein detail gegee word.

Personnel is altyd byderhand om elke gier te bevredig; of u op die strand ontspan, 'n aptyttekkertjie geniet, by die Givenschy spa gepammerlang word of 'n middagslapie in u persoonlike suite neem. Driester Michelin chef, Alain Cucasse is verantwoordelik vir die heerlike gourmetdisse wat in die "Spoon des Isle" opgetower word. Daar is ook 'n 24-uur kamerdiens beskikbaar wat alles op die restaurant se spyskaart kan voorsien aan diegene wat verkies om hulle maaltye in privaatheid te geniet.

Le Saint Geran is die enigste hotel ter wêreld wat aan hul gaste 'n glasie sjampagne bedien wanneer hulle vertrek – sekerlik sodat u die genoeglike skok van u hotelrekening beter sal kan hanteer! Vanselfsprekend sal sulke luuksheid en bederf nie goedkoop verkwasel word nie. Maar Le Saint Geran is elke sent werd, omdat u kan ontspan met die wete dat enigiets onder die son aan u voorsien sal word.

Tesame met die ongelooflike watersport en al die ander ontspanningsfasiliteite, is daar ook 'n 9-putjie golfbaan wat deur ons eie Gary Player ontwerp is; asook 'n ten volle toegeruste gimnasium.

Le Saint Geran, the luxurious flagship of Sun International in Mauritius, has been awarded 'Hotel of the Year' status by readers of UK based **Tatler** magazine.


