7644 Tamil Examiner's Report

General Comments

There were many pleasing performances this year. However, attention paid to orthography and to the construction of sentences is still inadequate. Out of the four questions, three were on translation- first Tamil to English and second English to Tamil.

Question 1

The candidates were required to translate into English a Tamil passage about the pollution of the environment and the ways to prevent it. The responses received for this question were weaker than the expected. Most of the candidates had difficulty in translating few words and phrases and that was kept in mind while marking the scripts.

Question 2

The candidates were asked to translate a tale from English to Tamil and it was clear that they did not have much difficulty in understanding the given English passage. However some candidates find it difficult to do the translation into Tamil accounted for the low scores.

Question 3

The candidates were asked to translate five sentences from English into Tamil and the answer were quite satisfactory. Nevertheless, some had difficulty in translating the sentences accurately into idiomatic Tamil.

Question 4

A good number of candidates had interesting ideas, facts and experiences to express but their organization and delivering were not considerably satisfying. Here again, inadequate linguistic skills and lexical proficiency were responsible for lower scores.
