

Greggs is the UK's largest bakery chain with nearly 1400 outlets. As the business has grown it has benefited from economies of scale. However, inflation has affected supplies and this causes pressures on profit levels.

Market research is conducted regularly to help management plan new products. Pressure from rivals means that Greggs is constantly looking at how to achieve the best marketing mix for their products. Busy peak periods often mean large queues in Greggs—such are the demands of customers for favourites such as sausage rolls.
