### Credit Listening

The marking scheme contains details that can be elicited from the text. The exact wording need not be adhered to, as long as the candidates' answers convey comprehension.

-½ for use of plural noun instead of singular, or vice versa.

-½ mark for use of wrong tense.

-1 mark for not contextualising vocabulary accurately.

-1 for not adhering to choices when multiple choice forms part of answer.
