As part of its leisure experience the S3 Social and Vocational Skills (S&VS) group has decided to take part in the “Go For It” activity programme organised by Inverfauld Cultural and Community Services. The programme will take place between Monday 19 and Friday 30 May inclusive. The group of nine boys, nine girls and two staff has chosen to attend on Thursday 29 May.

Activities on offer are fishing, canoeing, scuba diving, cycling, trampolining, 7-a-side football, uni hoc and extreme dodgeball. All activities are taken by qualified instructors, registered with Inverfauld Council Sports Development.

A maximum of two activities per day should be chosen. Due to the popularity of certain activities a third choice should be indicated on the application form, to avoid disappointment.

The cost of the programme is £12.50 per day or £55 per week. A packed lunch is available (at an additional charge of £2.95 per day).

Transport is available on request and should be requested at the booking stage.

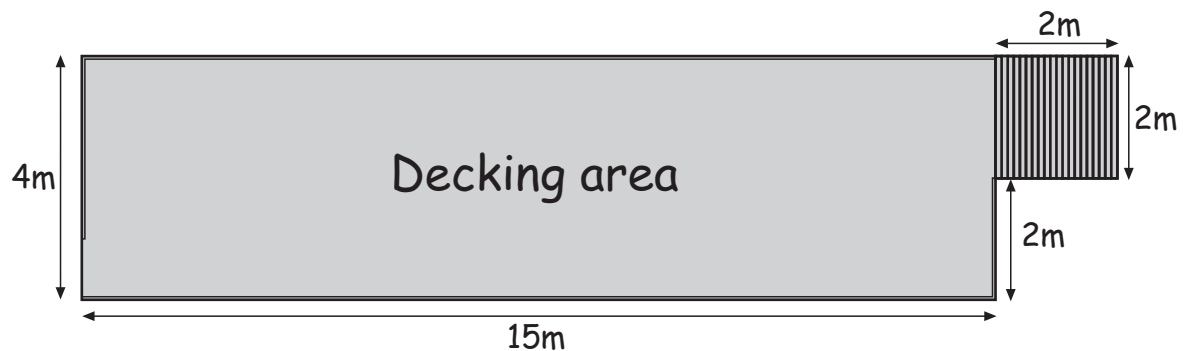

2. The S&VS group at Inverfauld School has decided to improve the garden decking area in the school wildlife garden to make it safer for disabled users.

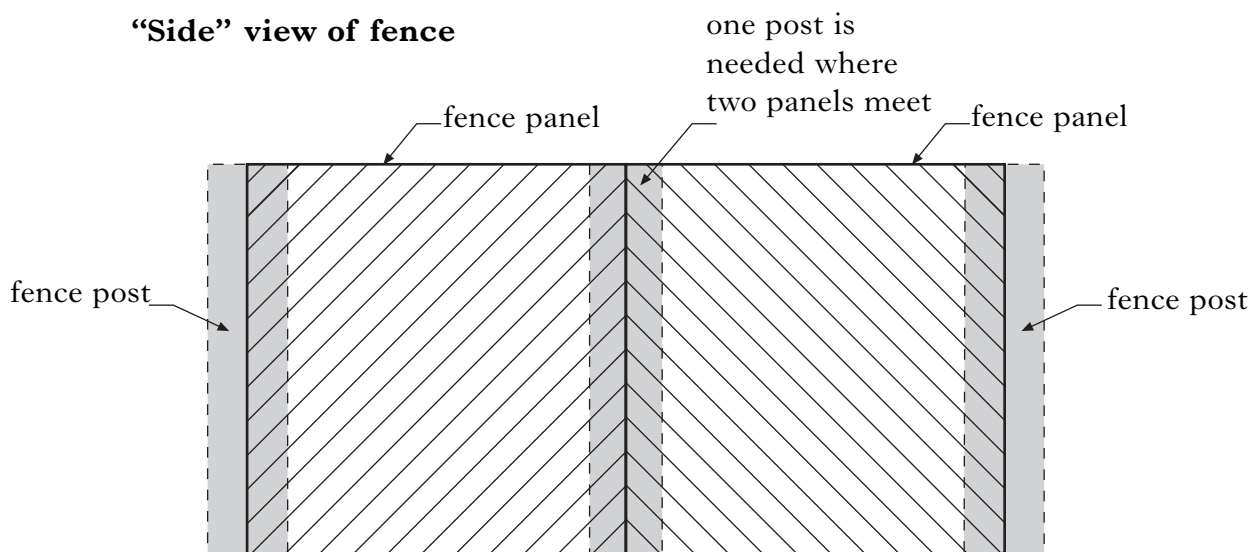
- A one metre high fence needs to be set up all round the perimeter of the decking area (except at the ramp).
- The decking area and ramp need to be painted with non-slip paint, for increased safety.

A plan of the decking area and a sketch of two sections of the proposed fencing is shown below.

All tools, nails and screws have been provided, at no cost, from school funds.

You need to order the following items from Inverfauld Hardware:

- Fencing – this is available in 1 metre and 2 metre panels costing £6.00 (1 m) and £4.00 (2 m) each.
- Fence posts – £2.50 each or £17.50 for sets of 8.
- Non-slip paint in 5 litre tins, for £5.00. Each tin holds enough paint to cover 8 square metres. Two coats are required for outdoor use.
