- TJ Smiths – provided the advertising
- Dunkelds – provided the prizes

Mrs Thomson from the Inverfauld Health and Leisure Centre came along to open the event and present the raffle prizes to the winners. The first prize was a one year membership to the health and leisure centre.

The pupils were successful in completing this challenge. They raised £375.

2. The S4 S&VS group at Inverfauld School have decided to grow vegetables on the patio outside the S&VS classroom.

They have decided to grow beans, peas, peppers and cucumbers.

They have:

- 36 bean plants
- 45 pea plants
- 12 pepper plants
- 8 cucumber plants.

They now need to order pots for the plants.

The planting should be carried out as follows:

- Beans should be planted 2 plants to each 30 cm pot
- Peas should be planted 3 plants to each 30 cm pot
- Pepper plants need one 20 cm pot each
- Cucumber plants need one 30 cm pot each.

A 30 cm pot needs 10 litres of multipurpose compost and a 20 cm pot needs 8 litres of multipurpose compost.

The group has £150.00 in S&VS funds to pay for the pots and compost. Using the information above and on the page opposite work out:

- the sizes and numbers of containers they will need
- the type, size and numbers of bags of compost they will need
- the cost of each item
- the total cost of ordering the items from Garden Planet
- the amount of money (if any) left in S&VS funds.

Set out this information clearly and on a single page.
