- be on one page
- be quick and easy for the employer to use
- have four headings based on the world of work plus one heading for attendance
- provide an opportunity to give a clear indication of the level of pupil performance
- be suitable for use by all employers.

Additional Information

Blane field is 25 miles from Inverfauld; allow 1 hour travel each way. The group will leave from the school and travel in the school minibus. The cost of this will be covered by school funds.

All performances begin at 2.30 pm and last approximately $2\frac{1}{2}$ hours. This will include a 20 minute interval when refreshments are sold. The audience is expected to be seated 10 minutes before the performance is due to begin.

The group will participate in the guided tour prior to the “Street Dance” performance.

Inverfauld Council has agreed to fund 50% of the total cost as part of the Arts Festival centenary year.
