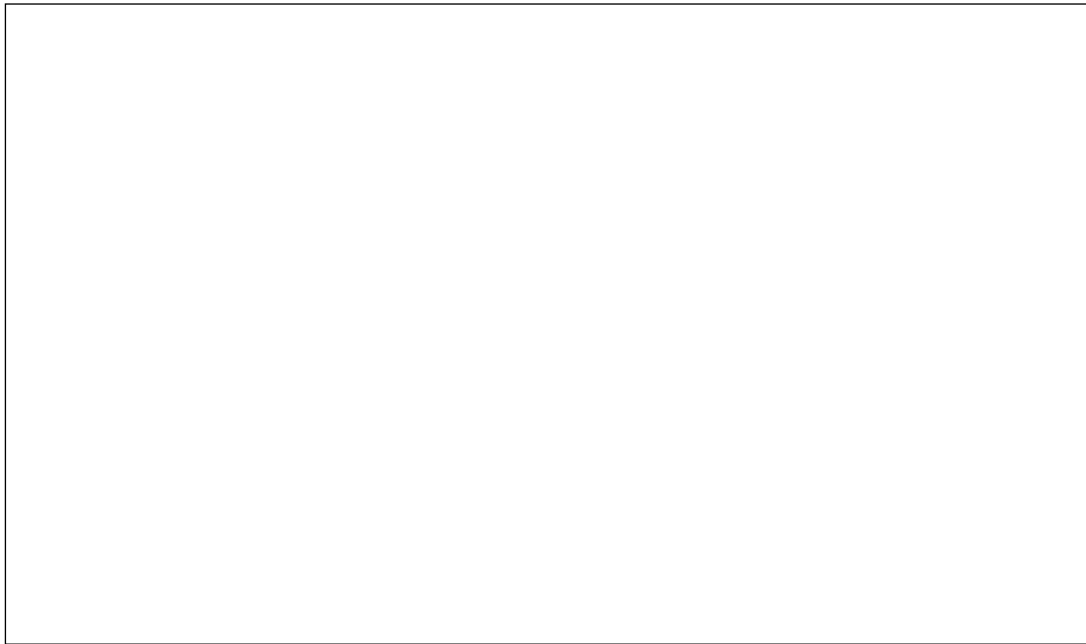

The disco will take place in the school hall on Monday 21st June 2010 between 7.30pm – 10.00pm.

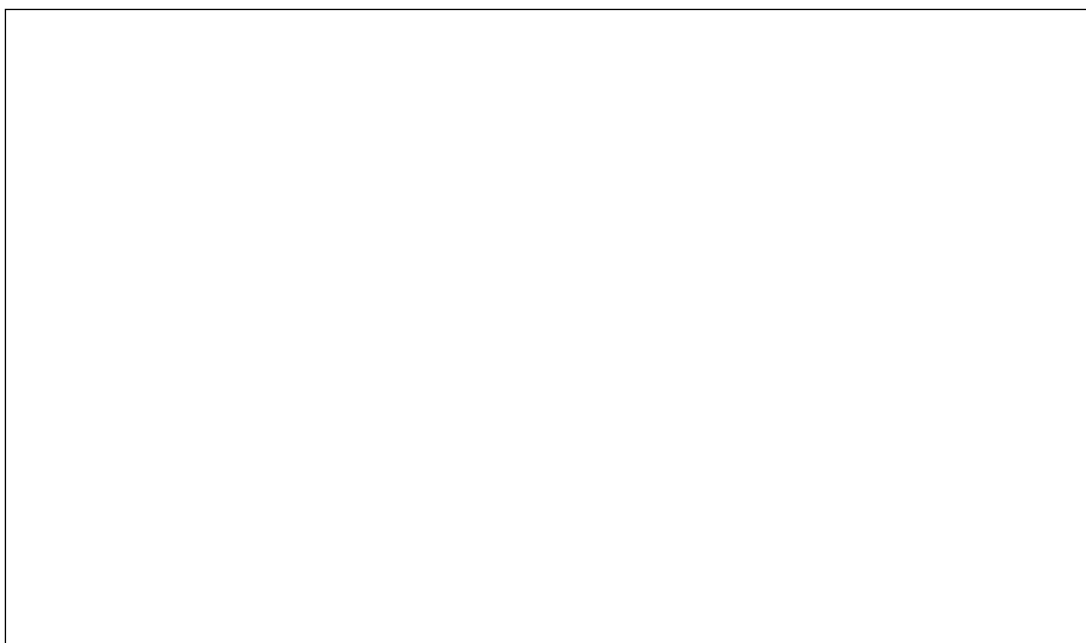

The start point and end point of each stage should be a town. (Use as many stages as you need for each journey.)

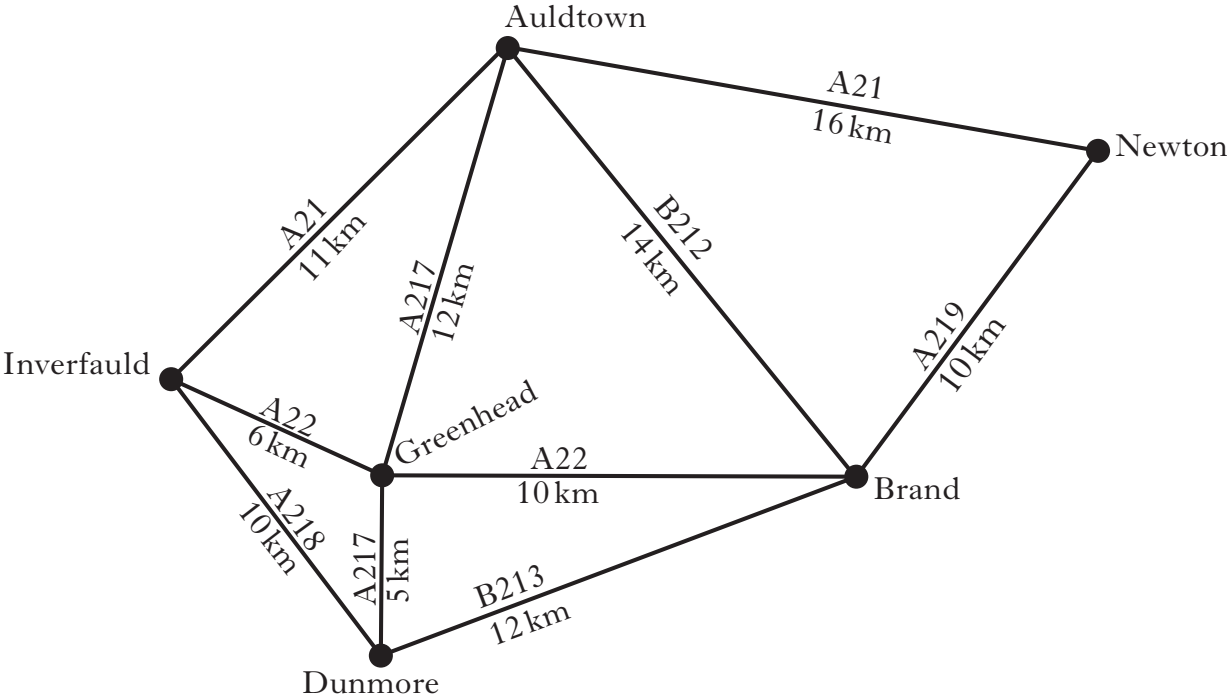
