



The long-tailed macaque is found in many nature parks in Singapore. With a population estimated at 850, it is one of the last remaining wild mammals that can still be found in the forested areas and mangrove forests in Singapore.

The macaques are bold and well-known for begging and snatching food from visitors. Some have even been known to enter homes of unsuspecting residents to steal food. When agitated, macaques become aggressive and may even bite.

As wild animals, the begging and snatching of food is not part of their natural instincts. Thoughtless visitors who disposed of leftover food 10 at parks or nature reserves is one reason why the macaques inherited a taste for human food. Well-meaning visitors, who think that the macaques do not have enough to eat, feed them too. Over time, macaques have got used to humans and always associate them with food.

One way to prevent the macaques from being over dependent on human beings for food is to stop feeding them. This forces them to search for their natural food source - namely insects, small reptiles, shoots and fruits. We could also make sure that all food brought into forested areas and disposed of in any of the monkey-proof rubbish bins 20 available.

The dog has worn the title of man's best friend for centuries as they provide companionship and joy. Dogs help bring in the newspapers, accompany their owners and even save lives by sniffing out victims trapped under collapsed buildings.

However, dogs have not always lived with humans. Before they were domesticated, they hunted other animals for food. However, in order to increase the chances of catching their prey they started to hunt in packs or groups. This behaviour can still be seen among the wild dogs found in Africa. Hunting in packs of between 10 and 20, they are known for their ability to run long distances without feeling tired. They have been also observed to possess a unique sense of intelligence in hunting.
