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SECTION A

Candidates must answer any <u>one</u> of the following questions from this section:

- 1. Assess the strengths and weaknesses of at least three different sociological theories in informing our understanding of contemporary sport.
- 2. Analyse the role of sport in shaping social constructions of masculinity and femininity. Use appropriate examples to justify your argument.
- 3. To what extent are racial inequalities reproduced through sport? Use appropriate examples to justify your argument.
- 4. Critically analyse the role of the media in the construction of identities and stereotypes surrounding sport. Use appropriate examples to justify your argument.
- 5. Critically assess the arguments that are used to oppose the practice of doping within sport. To what extent are these arguments credible?

SECTION B

Candidates must answer any one of the following questions from this section:

- 6. Assess the advantages and drawbacks of at least three different theories of globalisation in terms of understanding contemporary developments in global sport.
- 7. Critically analyse the impacts of globalisation on football's English Premier League (EPL). Use a range of appropriate examples to justify your argument.
- 8. Assess the claim that the international movement of athletes and coaches from one country to another is a powerful example of both the positive and negative effects of globalisation. Use appropriate examples to justify your argument.

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
