## DUTCH4TA5 – MAJOR AUTHORS

**Answer TWO questions. You may NOT answer a question on the writer who was the subject of your assessed essay. Each question carries equal weight.**

### QUESTION 1 – HUGO CLAUS

*Either:*

- a) Discuss *Het verdriet van België* as a portrait of the artist as a young man.

*Or:*

- b) Claus is a caricaturist rather than a realist. Discuss, with reference to *Het verdriet van België* and at least one of his plays.

### QUESTION 2 – HELLA HAASSE

*Either:*

- a) Analyse and discuss Hella Haasse's preoccupation with the self in *Een nieuwer testament* and *Sleuteloog*.

*Or:*

- b) Consider the relationship between Hella Haasse's exploration of the boundary between fact and fiction and her experimentation with genre. Refer to at least two of her works in your answer.

### QUESTION 3 – W.F. HERMANS

*Either:*

- a) "Het is of ik in een andere wereld leef, waar niemand mij geloven kan."  
[W.F. Hermans, *De donkere kamer van Damocles*, 1958, p. 345]  
Compare and discuss the theme of alienation and how this affects the main characters in *Nooit meer slapen* and *De donkere kamer van Damocles*.

*Or:*

- b) Consider the following critical reaction:  
"Zo gezien is *De donkere kamer van Damocles* één van de meest nihilistische romans die de Nederlandse literatuur heeft voortgebracht." [Ton Anbeek, *Geschiedenis van de Nederlandse literatuur*, p. 196].  
Discuss this critical statement and explore to what extent both *De donkere kamer van Damocles* and *Nooit meer slapen* can be considered 'nihilistic'.
