- 6. Why have right wing populist parties performed better in Norway and Denmark than in Sweden during the 1990s and after?
- 7. To what extent did the so-called 'Nordic Balance' work against a deeper level of Nordic integration during the period 1949-91?
- 8. What are the main reasons for the relatively high degree of gender equality in Scandinavia?
- 9. Analyse the implications of the proposed EU enlargement for the continued existence of Scandinavia or Norden as a distinctive region.
