- 4. Examine the ways Borges subverts the short story to create what he calls a 'ficción'.
- 5. 'The invasion of rational everyday reality by the irrational is a Cortazarean constant' (Cynthia Schmidt-Cruz). Discuss.
- 6. 'Cortázar's narrators are limited by age or by gender or by habit.' Examine this view in relation to the final meaning of his stories.
