## SPANISH S2307: The Subaltern in Latin American Culture

Candidates should not base their answers on any text or texts used extensively in their course-work essays.

- 1. 'Sab's slavery is employed to function as a metaphor of female bondage more than a plea to end the African slave trade.' Discuss Gómez de Avellaneda's Sab in the light of this statement.
- 2. 'En la poesía de César Vallejo se expresa el deseo de destruir las cadenas sociales que encarcelan al hombre, y también se rompen las leyes lingüísticas. Todo va en la misma dirección.' Discuss with reference to Vallejo's *Poemas humanos* AND/OR *España*, aparta de mí este cáliz.
- 3. 'The most innovatory feature of *Memorias del subdesarrollo* is not its revolutionary dimension but rather the filmic tricks it plays on the bourgeois viewer.' Evaluate Tomás Gutiérrez Alea's *Memorias del subdesarrollo* in the light of this observation.
- 4. 'En los cuentos de Luisa Valenzuela la política y el sexo se entremezclan y se polarizan de una manera sorprendente.' Using this comment as a basis for discussion, evaluate the short stories in Cambio de armas.
- 5. 'Me llamo Rigoberta Menchú challenges western conceptions about truth, history, and the social self.' To what extent do you agree?
- 6. Evaluate the appropriateness of using subaltern theory to analyse ONE of the written TEXTS OR FILMS studied in this course.
- 7. 'Politics is like a pistol shot in the theatre. It always ruins art.' Discuss with reference to ONE of the written TEXTS OR FILMS studied in this course.
- 8. How important is the form of a text in interpreting its message? Discuss with reference to ONE of the written TEXTS OR FILMS studied in this course.
