PAPER ENVSGX11: Principles and Practices of Cosmopolitan Development

- 4. Suggest how a particular urban programme or project with which you are familiar might contribute to a strategy of cosmopolitan development in cities in any part of the world.
- 5. In what ways can cosmopolitan development become institutionalised in urban government and management?
- 6. Explain, with illustrations, how the 'principles' of cosmopolitan development can be translated into elements of a planning agenda.
