1. Critically discuss the way in which the principle of social justice can be operationalised in urban development planning practice. Give examples to illustrate your arguments.
2. Critically discuss whether the notion of 'the public interest' is a useful concept in urban development planning. Use examples to illustrate your argument.
3. Compare and contrast the way participation is dealt with by the advocacy and collaborative approaches to planning. Use examples to illustrate your argument.
4. Discuss the likely policy basis for planning in a city planning case of your choice, explaining the reasons how this might have influenced the adoption of a particular planning approach.
5. In your opinion, which planning approaches have the best chance of addressing urban inequality and why? Use examples to illustrate your arguments.
6. It has been argued that "the disentanglement of urban management from the neo-liberal paradigm" (Werna, 1995, p 358) is essential to its future survival. Discuss the validity of this argument in the light of contemporary urban conditions.
